## BYLAW NO. 124

A Bylaw to extend the permitted use of plastic plumbing materials.

Under the provision of Section 83 of the Public Health Act, R.S.S. 1978, the Council of the Village of Neilburg in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of:
  - a) Bylaw No. 73, to regulate plumbing and drainage and the disposal sewage, and
  - b) The Saskatchewan Plumbing and Drainage Regulations, 1978 enacted under the Public Health Act, R.S.S., 1978 Irvin Dueck of Neilburg, Saskatchewan is hereby authorized to use plastic pipe and fittings in the plumbing system serving the structure known as Bake Shop and Eating Establishment located on Lot 1, Block 15, Plan #81-B-10587.
- 2. The construction of such plumbing shall comply to the requirements stipulated under subsection (a) and (b):
  - (a) Combustible drain, waste and vent piping shall not be used in a plumbing system within a building where part of the system is located within or passes through a fire separation required to have a fire-resistance rating, except that where drain, waste and vent piping penetrates through a vertical fire separation, the piping on one side may be combustible provided the combustib piping is not located in a vertical shaft or in a fire separation required to have a fire-resistance rating.
  - (b) Meet the requirements imposed by:
    - i) The office of the Provincial Fire Commissioner, and
    - ii) All other provisions of Bylaw No. 73 governing plumbing and drainage and the disposal of sewage within the Village of Neilburg.
- 3. This bylaw shall come into force and effect upon approval of the Minister of Health.
