

BYLAW NO. 201

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF A STREET

The Council of the Village of Neilburg, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in open meeting hereby enacts as follows: -

WHEREAS Section 156 of *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984* allows a municipality to permanently close any street or lane vested in the Crown with the prior written consent of the Minister of Highways and Transportation AND after having given the public notice of the proposed closure;


AND WHEREAS the Minister of Highways and Transportation has consented to AND Council has given the required public notice of the proposed closure;


THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Neilburg, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- (1) To permanently close the following public highway described as:

All that portion of Second Street East lying north of the north limit of First Avenue and lying south of a straight line joining the southwest corner of lane Plan 85B0777 and the most easterly southeast corner of lane Plan 61B04464 as said street is shown and was vested on Plan BT6096.

- (2) That the Administrator undertake such other things necessary to effect the intent of this Bylaw.
(3) That Bylaw 191 is repealed.
