

BYLAW NO. 53

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The council of the Village of Neilburg, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:-

- 1) For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "public highway" means any street, lane or public highway within the village, but does not include a provincial highway therein as designated pursuant to the provisions of the Highways Act;
 - (b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Vehicles Act.
- 2) No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than twenty-five miles per hour on a public highway within the limits of the village.
- 3) Section 2 shall not apply to fire engines, fire department apparatus or police cars when on emergency duty.
- 4) Any person guilty of an infraction of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the village.
